

## Student-Athlete & Parent Agreement & Guidelines

### Student-Athlete Agreement

1. I commit to doing all my school work, all of the time, on time, with my best effort, & I will not use school work as an excuse to miss practice / games.
2. I agree to commit to the team and the coaching staff for one complete season, promising not to quit even when things get tough.
3. I know that I am required to come to all practices & games.
4. There are two acceptable reasons for missing school, practice, or a game: Serious illness to myself or a serious family urgency that requires me to be there. I will call my head coach ahead of time in this case.
5. I will participate in all required fundraisers to help pay for team expenses.
6. I understand failure to meet the above requirements has harmful effect on me as a player, teammates & coaches, and appropriate consequences will result.
7. Quitting the team, meaning, failure to complete the entire season through all competitions will result in an “F” quarter grade for Athletics/Football, forfeiture of Varsity (or JV) Letter, banquet privileges and any other special rewards.
8. I will remain free of tobacco, drugs, alcohol, and environments in which they are used.

### Parental Agreement

1. I agree to promote & check my child’s academic growth (all schoolwork), and support the commitment to the team for one complete season (no quitting).
2. I will seriously monitor my child’s academic & athletic progress, yet I will not hurt their commitment to the team by withholding them from practices or games for disciplinary reasons. It is suggested to withhold privileges (allowances, T.V., iPod, music, video games, free time with friends at night and on weekends, or other hobby / materials) NOT a commitment or responsibility to the school / team. I will not allow them to quit during the season.
3. I will call or send a letter ahead of time in the case of any absences that requires my child to be there, and I understand there are consequences for my student-athlete involved with missing required practices, tournaments, and games.
4. I understand there are expenses associated with high school athletics, and I will participate in required fundraising, & uphold my child’s fundraising responsibilities.
5. I understand and accept: 1) Failure to meet the above requirements has a harmful effect on my son as a player, teammates and coaches; and 2) the above consequences for quitting the team before the entirety of the season.

## Team Fees, Fundraisers, & Other Guidelines

1. Once contracted on the team, each individual player is responsible for \$900.00 in team fees which are used for team benefits (Year Round Football, Passing League & Tournaments, Spirit Pack, Banquet, Team Meals, Coaches' Pay, Athletic Trainers, etc.)
2. Team members will need to acquire their own cleats, extra team shirts & shorts, & other non-essential gear (extra fund raising can be done to offset costs).
3. The \$900.00 participation fee is due and payable with the signing of this contract. However the Booster Club offers the option paying \$400 prior to the start of Summer Camp (6/21/10) with the remaining \$500 balance to be paid PRIOR to the player being issued football equipment in mid-July. In cases of hardship, a monthly payment plan can be arranged which must be approved by the Executive Board and Coach White or equipment will not be issued to your player.
4. Any athlete / family that violates this contract and does not complete the entire season for any reason, including being dismissed from the team for disciplinary reasons, will still be responsible for any remaining team fees (no matter what stage of the season the team is in).
5. Any doctor, dentist, counseling appointments, make-up tests & quizzes, or other personal matters need to be made around the practice schedule or in a way that athlete does not miss any part of practice for that day. Any part or full practice missed requires make-up (Except excused absences confirmed ahead by parent & athlete contract).
6. This agreement also allows the Edison Football Coaches & Booster Club Board Members to use student or parent addresses, home or cell phones numbers, and e-mail addresses to make personal contact for team & booster related purposes.
7. The Edison Football Varsity Lettering Policy is at the discretion of the Varsity Football Coaches, and is based on adherence to this contract and significant contribution to the Edison Varsity Football Program as a player in games or in practice. The Charger Football Varsity Letter is of high regard & won't be granted lightly.
8. If you have any questions, need help, or would like to meet with me, call me or e-mail me and arrangements will be made.

Compliance with the above guidelines and requirements will result in a successful experience on this team, positive outcomes, and freedom from negative consequences
